



NAO Network Pass FAQ (2025-2026)

Network Passes, available exclusively to NAO members, are the most flexible and affordable way to deep-dive into NAO's network sessions. These events cover topics ranging from human resources to financial management, fundraising, and more. The NAO network season kicks off each fall, with monthly sessions from September through May. To get the most out of these passes, sales will be open only until Monday, December 1, 2025. Get yours now before this opportunity passes you by!

Frequently Asked Questions

A. What is an NAO Network?

NAO facilitates six (6) [Regional Networks](#) across Oregon. The networks are based in Portland, Corvallis, Eugene-Springfield, Medford, and Bend. Of the 50+ training events held as part of the network season, more than 20 are offered virtually and are accessible to nonprofit professionals statewide.

Our networks bring together nonprofit leaders to share best practices and tangible tools, connect with peers, and learn with thought leaders. These networks are designed for nonprofit professionals wanting to learn more about best practices while advancing their skills in nonprofit management, financial accountability, and equity and inclusion.

B. What is a Network Pass?

A Pass functions like a "punch card," allowing NAO members to pre-purchase registrations to redeem at any network session. We have now expanded the use of passes to be eligible for our virtual offerings, including most single-day webinars from September to May.

C. How many sessions are included in a Network Pass? Can I purchase multiple Network Passes?

A Network Pass grants you access to ten (10) sessions, redeemable for any network session (in-person or virtual) and NAO-hosted webinars. You may purchase additional Network Passes. However, passes cannot be gifted to non-member organizations.

D. If a webinar is significantly cheaper than an in-person or virtual network, can I use one pass for two registrations?

No, you cannot. While our typical 60-90 minute webinars are a great value on their own and do not receive a further discount with the purchase of the Network Pass, we have opened the opportunity for pass holders to apply the pass to webinars outside of the Network offerings, giving you a broader selection to choose from.



E. Where can I use my Network Pass?

Passes may be used for sessions at *any* NAO Network and NAO Webinars. For example, if you live in Medford and buy a Network Pass, you might use your pass for any combination of the following:

- In-person sessions held in Medford as part of the Rogue Valley Nonprofit Network (RVNN).
- Webinars. Excludes cohorts and multi-day virtual workshops.
- Any of the 20+ Virtual Network sessions held as part of other networks.

Tip: Look for *“This session is Network Pass eligible.”* On the registration pages, under the session price, in the body of the event description.

G. When can I use my Network Pass?

Once purchased, you will receive a personalized discount code that will be active from the time of purchase through the end of May 2026. Use your discount code at checkout when registering for a session. We cannot refund unused sessions on your Network Pass, nor can we apply them to other trainings or next year’s network events.

H. Can I share my Network Pass?

A Network Pass can be shared with anyone in your organization. If you’re unable to attend a session but a colleague or board member would like to go, they can use your Network Pass instead. You can also transfer your registration to another member of your organization if needed.

I. Can I bring a guest using my Network Pass?

For pass holders wanting to bring a guest, we’ve simplified the process. Just use your personalized discount code when registering (register each additional guest separately). Each guest you invite will count as one deduction from your pass (up to ten registrations per pass). Also, keep in mind that you can buy multiple passes during the sale period.



J. How much am I *actually* saving by purchasing a Network Pass?

NAO members **save up to \$200** by purchasing a Network Pass instead of buying individual tickets to network events.
